The Great Feast of Pentecost, which we celebrate this weekend, reminds us of the vitality of the early Church. The coming of the Holy Spirit breathed new life into the gathering of the followers of Jesus in the midst of confusing times. We pray often for this vitality and new life in our Church today.

As our province begins to consider how and when activities can commence once more, our Diocese and our Parish is preparing for the time when we are able to re-open our churches. The Bishops of Ontario are working to determine how we will proceed. We want to ensure that everyone can worship in a safe environment. In our own parish I have been looking at best practices in other places, working with medical experts and consulting to determine what to do in the days ahead.

We do know that there will continue to be restrictions on large gatherings in the days ahead, until it is safe to resume them. There will likely be a "phased" approach, a gradual return to public celebration of the sacraments. Even then, our new reality in church may be different from what we were accustomed to in the past, with some continuing precautions, since we want to resume public gatherings in a way that does not lead to a re-igniting of the pandemic.

One way we are planning for the day when we can re open our Church, is by installing technology which will make it possible to worship in three venues - the church, in the Parish Centre and by livestream. This will be necessary if we are going to be able to serve our community in the days to come. If you are able to assist us with the costs of this, which will be very necessary - indeed essential - in the days to come, I would ask that, if you are able, that you please consider a contribution to aide with the costs of this through our website and designate it for "Covid-19 Re Opening"

In the meantime, our leadership teams are working diligently to prepare our campus for reopening, *when that is possible*. We miss you all very much and want to welcome our multigenerational community in the safest and strongest way.
