Weekly Gospel Reflection (Jn 14:1-12)

The CWL leads the Rosary in the church on Tuesday evenings at 6:30 prior to the 7pm Mass. All are welcome to join.

Our Lady of Fatima Feast Day: May 13

May 13 is the anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady to three shepherd children in the small village of Fatima in Portugal in 1917. She appeared six times to Lucia, 9, and her cousins Francisco, 8, and his sister Jacinta, 6, between May 13, 1917 and October 13, 1917. In the last apparition the woman revealed her name in response to Lucia's question: "I am the Lady of the Rosary." What is the central meaning of the message of Fatima? Nothing different from what the Church has always taught: it is, as Pope Benedict the XVI, has put it, "the exhortation to prayer as the path of 'salvation for souls' and, likewise, the summons to penance and conversion." What is Rosary why do we pray it?

The word "Rosary" from the Latin word "rosarium" means rose garden, or bouquet of roses. In our Catechism Rosary is called a "meditation [that] engages thought, imagination, emotion, and desire. This ... is necessary in order to deepen our ... faith, prompt the conversion of our heart, and strengthen our will to follow Christ. Christian prayer tries above all to meditate on the mysteries of Christ, as ... the rosary ..." (CCC 2708). Pope Saint John Paul II declared the rosary his favorite

prayer, a "prayer for peace and for the family." Pope Benedict XVI: "without a doubt, this one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and His Mother, Mary... this prayer

helps to put Christ at the center."

Pope Francis: "a prayer that always accompanies me; it is also the prayer of the ordinary people and the Saints...it is a prayer from my heart."
