THE FAITH EXPLAINED - What is Holy Communion?

Holy Communion is a unique encounter with Christ, in which we sacramentally receive Christ into our bodies. Our Catechism explains: In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained (CCC 1374).

The Catechism uses the words "really, truly, and substantially" to describe Christ's presence in the Holy Eucharist in order to emphasize that Holy Communion is not a sign or symbol of Christ but the real presence of the Lord.
