Weekly Gospel Reflection (Lk 23:35-43)



As we celebrate today the **Solemnity of Christ the King**, we wonder why "Christ the King"? Why does the Church celebrate the title which Jesus himself had avoided during His whole earthly life? The fact that the throne of Christ is the Cross, is the answer. The power of God is shown not in a display of spectacular dominance, but in weakness, in total self-sacrifice. It will be only later with the Resurrection that the moment of weakness can be seen as one of true power of God.

Christ the King dying on the Cross shows that the meaning of life, happiness if you will, is found in the paradox, in making our life a gift for others.

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

Each year we celebrate Christ's sovereignty on the last Sunday of the liturgical year, the 34th Sunday in Ordinary Time. This year the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ is on **November 20th**, **2022**.

Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. The Church calls us to acknowledge Christ's kingship with our whole lives:

He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things ... He must reign in our bodies ... which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls ... (Quas primas, 33)

Advent Retreat Night with Bishop Lobsinger Wednesday, December 7, 2022 at 7 pm


