# THE FAITH EXPLAINED - Solemnity, Feast, **Memorial** – what is the difference?

A **Solemnity** is the highest rank of liturgical celebration. The Gloria and Creed are always said on such days. Easter, Christmas, the Ascension, Corpus Christi, and other celebrations of events in our Lord's life are Solemnities. A Feast is the next rank down. The Gloria is required on these days, but not the Creed. They consist of the celebration of certain saints like the Archangels or the Apostles. A **Memorial** is the lowest rank and are simply the celebrations of most of the saints. The Gloria and Creed are not said on these days. (Expert: Catholic Answers)
