Today we begin Advent!

Today, on the First Sunday of Advent we begin a new liturgical year. We move into the "Year A" cycle of readings. The Gospel - on most Sundays – will be taken from the Gospel of Matthew.

Advent (from Latin *ad-venio*, 'to come to') is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to both, the celebration of Our Lord's birth on Christmas and Christ's coming into our life daily. Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days.

Advent Wreath

Traditionally the Advent wreath is constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent. Usually, three candles are purple, and one is rose. The purple candles symbolize the preparatory sacrifices and good works undertaken at this special time. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday, *Gaudete Sunday*, which is the Sunday of rejoicing, because the faithful have arrived at the midpoint of Advent, and they are close to Christmas.
