# The Feast of Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, November 9 - Mass at 12:15 pm

November 9<sup>th</sup> marks the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome by Pope Sylvester I in 324. This church [not St. Peter's Basilica] is the cathedra (chair) of the bishop of Rome [that is, Pope]. A Latin inscription reads "omnium ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis mater et caput" (The Mother and Head of All Churches of the City and the World.) ... (Excerpt from Living With Christ)

This feast reminds us that each of us is the temple of God. St. Paul writes: "... do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you ... therefore glorify God in your body" (1Cor 6:19-20).

# St. Michael's Refugee Support Team

The Refugee Support Team remains engaged with many of the Ukrainians whom we supported over the summer months when they were living nearby. Most are now employed, (locally, in Palmerston and in the Toronto area) and some have returned to Ukraine. # St. Michael's Refugee Update

The parish applied in 2017 to sponsor a Rohingya family (living as refugees in Bangladesh since 1992). In 2019, the family took up residence in India. Twice they were on their way but the process stopped. In 2020, the pandemic shut everything down. In 2022, they were granted their travel visa to Canada but India was not issuing exit visas to any Rohingya families and the visa expired. This fall, we are again hopeful that they will be

successful. Please keep Abu, his wife and their 3 children in your prayers. Their adult son arrived separately from them last summer and is doing very well, learning English and getting used to life in Canada.

This weekend, members of the committee will be at all Masses to give an update on the Harambee Child Sponsorship Program, the Notre Dame Children Outreach program and the construction of the Blessed Theresa of Jesus Hardinger Educational Centre in Nyalieng'a Kenya.
