# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 20:27-38)



Answering the question about the resurrection of the dead, Jesus recalls God's words spoken to Moses, "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob" (Ex 3:6). These words imply that Abraham and the patriarchs are still alive because, as Jews believed, God could not be named after a dead person.

By quoting this text, Jesus brings the whole question about the afterlife to the question of God's love for us. What Jesus is saying is this: because God loves people and is faithful to them, He cannot leave them in the power of death. When our life ceases, God's love for us stays. We are to be alive forever because of the love of God.

# The Feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran November 9, Mass at 12:15 pm

The feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran is celebrated by the entire Church. It marks the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome by Pope Sylvester I in 324. This church is the cathedra (or chair) of the bishop of Rome, who is the Pope. A Latin inscription in the Church reads: "omnium ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis mater et caput." Translated, this means, "The mother and head of all churches of the city and of the world." The basilica was originally named the Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior. However, it is called St. John Lateran because it was built on property donated to the Church by the Laterani family, and because the monks from the monastery of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Divine served it.
