Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 18:1-8)

By this story Jesus emphasizes the power of persistent faith and trust. The Lord assures us that if we trust in God, even when God seems to be silent and unmoved, He will answer our prayers. The parable does not say that what we pray for will be granted exactly as we wish; it emphasizes that God won't disappoint us.

We pray the Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. The CWL will lead the Rosary in the parish on Tuesday evenings at 6:30 prior to the 7pm mass. All are welcome to join together in this wonderful prayer.

Feast of St. Luke, Tuesday, October 18th - Mass 7pm

St. Luke is the author of the third Gospel and of the Acts of the Apostles. He was a companion of St. Paul and according to tradition he was a physician. Ancient traditions acknowledge Luke as the founder of Christian iconography, making him a patron of artists as well as physicians. It is believed that Luke was born a Greek and a Gentile (that is non-Jewish).

The journey proposed by the third Gospel is profoundly marked by listening to the Word of God which, like a seed, must be received with goodness and promptness of heart, overcoming the obstacles that prevent it from taking root and bearing fruit (cf. Lk 8: 4-15). (See, St. John Paul II, Feast of St. Luke).

Memorial of St. John Paul II, Saturday, October 22. Adoration and Exposition of the Relic of Saint John Paul II, 3pm– 4pm

St. John Paul II was a Pope with exceptional apostolic zeal for families, young people, and the sick. That zeal led him to more than two hundred pastoral visits outside of the Vatican. His feast day (like John XXIII) is not celebrated on the day of his death, as we usually celebrate saints, but on the day when he was elected Pope, October 22, 1978.

Join us for Adoration and Exposition of the First-Class Relic of the Saint on Saturday from 3pm to 4pm. At 3pm we will say the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
