Our Lady of the Rosary, Friday October 7th Mass 8am, Adoration 8:30am-9am

On this day we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V realized that the Holy League needed great spiritual assistance, so he asked the Holy League, as well as all of the faithful, to pray the Rosary, asking Our Lady's intercession for a victory in the upcoming battle. The evening before the famous battle, the sailors prayed the Rosary on their knees. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
