FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mt 22:34-40)



Today's Gospel speaks about the great commandant of love. What love means is shown vividly and well in the parable of the Good Samaritan (Lk 10:25-37). Love, as presented in the New Testament, is not how we feel about people but what we do for them.

The commandment to love God and our neighbor that Jesus proposed was not new. It was already taught in the Book of Deuteronomy (6:4ff) and Leviticus (19:18). What is new is that Jesus presents love for God and love for a neighbor as inseparable from each other. He is saying, love for God is shown by love for people, particularly the most vulnerable among us.

All Saints Day and All Souls Day - what is the difference?

All Saints Day is a Solemn Holy Day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on *November 1st*. This day is dedicated to all the Saints, that is, those who have attained heaven both officially canonized and uncanonized. All Souls Day is observed on *November 2nd* and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven.



All Saints – Solemnity Wednesday, November 1st Mass at 12:15 pm

Saints are people whom the Church proclaims explicitly and publicly and without error that they are in heaven. ... But there are many more saints in heaven than we can count or find in our liturgical calendar... That's why we have ... the great Feast of All Saints — to honor not only the canonized but also and especially the uncanonized saints ... (see, Excerpt from: Fr. All Souls Day Thursday, November 2nd Mass at 12:15 pm and 7:00 pm

Our Catholic Faith has always believed that "it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for both the living and the dead." For this reason, we celebrate the feast of All Souls. At both Masses we pray for deceased Parishioners. At the 7 pm Mass the names of our Parishioners who have died during this past year will be read and remembered.

How do I gain an indulgence for the dead?

There are certain indulgences that apply only to the dead. For example, from November 1 through November 8 if you visit a grave and pray for the person you can obtain a plenary indulgence for the deceased individual. And on

November 2 you can obtain a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory if you devoutly visit a church and pray an Our Father and the Creed. (Expert from Catholic Answers)
