FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 19:1-10)



In today's Gospel Zacchaeus undergoes a total transformation, from a tax collector and swindler to a philanthropist. We wonder what has caused that change in his life. In the presence of Jesus, Zacchaeus discovers deep truth about God and about himself. He learns who he really is and what he is made for. In other words, in the loving-kindness of the Lord, Zacchaeus experiences, probably the first time in his life, that he is accepted and loved. That experience turns around his life.

The story is a vivid image of what happens when we allow God to enter our "house," that is, when we allow God to embrace us in His mercy.

What is the difference between All Saints Day and All Souls Day?

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrates annually on November 1st. This day is dedicated to all the saints, that is, those who have attained heaven both officially canonized and uncanonized. All Saints Day should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2nd, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven.

ALL SAINTS DAY Tuesday, November 1st – Mass at 7 pm

The great Feast of All Saints is about celebrating all the saints canonized and uncanonized. Of course, we are very familiar with the canonized saints. These are the saints whom the Church proclaims explicitly and publicly... Most likely there are many more uncanonized saints in heaven than there are canonized. Some of them might be members of our families.

Mother Angelica says, "being a saint is being who you were meant to be: a frail human being keeping the commandments. It is loving when you are not loved in return. It's being patient when you want to hit someone on the head. It is loving your family as they are, not as you want them to be. It is not letting the disappointments in your life crush you."
