

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mt 21: 33-43)



In today's parable, God is presented like a landowner who sends his only beloved son to protect his vineyard. The vineyard stands for each of us. When the son is killed, Jesus proclaims, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone." These words refer to Jesus' death and His Resurrection. It is to say that the death of the Son of God is not the last word; paradoxically it becomes a source of hope and life for all.

Today's Gospel emphasizes with strength that God is not helpless in dealing with sin and evil. When everything seems to be lost, precisely then, God finds new and greater ways for His love.
