FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 17:11-19)



In today's Gospel ten people are cured from leprosy but only one is told by Jesus, "Your faith has made you well." Ten people are cured but only one is truly made well. This indicates there are two kinds of healing: one that is physical, affecting the body; another, more profound, reaching the depths of a person's heart. To cure the body is one thing but to heal the wounded soul and heart is something different.

In the Bible leprosy symbolizes the defilement of sin, so today's Gospel emphasizes that only God can forgive sins and heal the outside and the inside. God forgives our sins cheerfully and generously, but those who ask for His mercy can experience forgiveness and healing.
