I am deeply grateful to almost 30 parishioners who have signed up for new ministry involvements this Fall. One very special area will be our expanded Ministry of Care to our Elders, Sick and Shut ins. This new ministry will see us visiting and ministering every Sunday to our elderly members. Thank you to all who have worked so hard this summer to make it possible for our shut in to receive the Lord on His Day. Another great aspect of this ministry is that we are now also going to have Mass once each week at one our elder care facilities – every Friday morning one of our facilities will have Mass – what a blessing!

Next weekend another area of expanded ministry begins - we resume our Children's Ministry but at both our 9:00am and 11:00am Masses where we have a full series of opportunities for children from Aged 2 - Grade 4 to participate in their own unique program. This year we will also offer "Searching in the Spirit", a four session evening gathering for young people preparing for Confirmation. CHANGE OF PRACTICE FOR COMMUNION

Recently, the Diocese of Hamilton reminded us that we are not in accord with the preferred practice for the taking of communion to the homebound. Beginning on September 1, 2019, it will no longer be acceptable to bring a pyx forward in the communion line and request an additional host(s) for a homebound member. Ministers of Communion will be instructed not to place communion hosts in pyxes. The following is the preferred practice of our Diocese:

Pyxes should be placed prior to the Mass on a tray near the Gift Table (along with the gifts of bread and wine). If you require more than one host you would arrange that with the priest beforehand, otherwise each pyx will have one host placed in it by the priest. This tray will be brought forth in the offertory procession. The hosts are consecrated with all the bread to be used for Communion and then, following the Post-Communion Prayer, those who are bringing Communion to the sick and homebound are invited to come forward to pick up the pyx(es) and are sent forth immediately. The final blessing follows.

If someone is not able or does not wish to place a pyx on the tray and come to the front, then they may approach the priest after Mass but not during the communion procession.

Thank you for your understanding during this transition so that our parish practice can reflect the preferred practice of our wider Diocese.
