### MARRIAGE ANNIVERSARY MASS

The Gift of Marriage is one to be cherished and celebrated. Our Feast Day Weekend (September 28/29) is a wonderful opportunity to do so. So save the date of **Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at the 11:00a.m. Mass** for the celebration of Marriage Jubilees in our parish for those celebrating their 5th, 10th, 15th, 20th, 25th etc.... anniversaries. Since returning home last January, I find myself more and more in awe at the goodness and generosity of the people of St Michael Parish. Let me give you some examples recently:

- Our "Ready Day One" School Supply Campaign collected over 6,000 items to help young people in need prepare for their first day of school.
- Our "Baby Bottle Campaign" to support Marillac Place collected \$5,041 (29% increase from 2017) plus donations for the "Comfort Baskets" (blankets, sheets, pillows, etc)
- We have increased the number of parishioners involved as Ministers of Communion to the Sick from 10 to over 30 and are able to bring communion on Sundays to all the residents at our four Retirement/Long Term Care residences and now have monthly Masses on Fridays at each residence in addition to weekly rosary at many.
- We have increased the number of parishioners involved as leaders in our Children's Ministry from just over 12 to 30 and been able to expand our ministry to two Masses (9am and 11am) and our age groups to now be Age 2-Grade 4 with a new curriculum which uses sight and sound in proclaiming God's word!
- We have introduced Video Screens in our entrances to share information on parish life and created our new Welcome Desk to answer questions from guests/parishioners and aid with upcoming events. These are great tools to welcome new parishioners and families.
- We have freshened the look of our Parish Centre and begun consultations on future enhancements to this important space in our parish life.
- We have seen considerable increase in our St John Paul Student Centre activities and many more students involved in our parish life. What a blessing!!
