Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 16:19-31)

The parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus highlights the indifference of the rich man towards the poor. The rich man does not end up in Hades because of his wealth or immoral conduct but because of his indifference. This is all Jesus emphasizes.

The Lord calls us to take special care for the "Lazarus" of today, the refugee, the unborn, victims of human trafficking, and in fact, all those whose voices may not usually be noticed or heard. The parable is meant, not to give details about the afterlife or scare us with images of punishment, but to invite us to open our eyes and hearts to those we pass by every day.

The Feast of the Holy Archangels

The three archangels whom the Church honors by name are St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael. They are also the only three angels who are mentioned by name in Sacred Scripture. The Feast of all three Archangels is September 29. As Pope emeritus Benedict XVI explains, "the Angel is a creature who stands before God, oriented to God with his whole being. All three names of the Archangels end with the word "El," which means "God." God is inscribed in their names, in their nature. Their true nature is existing in his sight and for him."
