Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 9:38-48)

At the time of Jesus, there was a tendency to make God's Kingdom an exclusive club, limited to chosen people. So, the Lord reminds us that the Kingdom of God is larger than one might think. In God's Kingdom, the Spirit works as it wills (Jn 3:8), and in a variety of people.

Like the disciples in today's Gospel, some people may think they can control how and where the Spirit acts. By saying, "whoever is not against us is for us" Jesus rejects such an arrogant approach. God's love is powerful enough to let a particular Christian attitude occur outside the church.

1. How did the First Friday Devotion begin?

In 1673, a French Visitandine (Visitation) nun named Margaret Mary Alacoque had visions of Jesus, wherein he asked the Church to honor His Most Sacred Heart. In particular, Jesus asked the faithful to "receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months." (alteia.org, 5 Things Catholics Should Know About First Fridays.)
