LENTEN RECOLLECTION ON THE MEANING OF THE EASTER TRIDUUM: SYMBOL OF DIVINE MERCY (Exploring the Liturgies of Holy Week) – Saturday, April 8, 2017 9:45am to 12:00 noon in the Church Hall. Presenter – Fr. Bosco Wong.

PARISH PENITENTIAL SERVICE: with individual absolution will be celebrated this **Tuesday**, **April 4**th **at 7:00pm with Fr. Tavis Goski.** Also, individual confession is available through the Lenten Period at 4:00pm every Saturday evening and a half-hour before all Masses on weekdays.

1) Lenten Reflection:

Today's gospel (John 11:1-45) records the raising of Lazarus from



the dead. Once again we find an image of baptism. In baptism, we die and rise in Christ, we rise to new and everlasting life. When Jesus first heard that Lazarus was ill, he said, "This illness does not lead to death; rather it is for God's glory, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it." Likewise, the new life that we have received through baptism should be a life that leads to God's glory. This week is a good time for us to look at our lives from the point of view of God's glory. Do our lives really give glory to God? Are there pockets in our lives where we do not give glory to God? (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165)

- 2) Why is it important to attend the Triduum celebrations? The Triduum (three days) celebrations mark the culmination of the Church's liturgical calendar. It marks the Lenten transition into the Easter Season. Beginning with the Last Supper after Sundown, when we introduce the oils blessed at the Chrism Mass by the bishop, to be used throughout the year; we commemorate Jesus celebrated the meal with the disciples, and urged them to serve one another in the foot washing; we transfer the Blessed Sacrament to be used on Good Friday to a place of repose. The first day ends with the Passion account from John, when we commemorate his death for us: We pray the solemn intercessions, venerate the cross and conclude with communion. On the second day, from Sundown of Good Friday to the time before Sundown, the church has no special liturgical celebration (except for the solemn devotion of the Stations of the Cross), but awaits through prayer and the elect prepares for their initiation. On nightfall of the third day, the church celebrates the joyful resurrection of the Lord. The fire is blessed, paschal candle is lit from the fire, marking Christ as light of the world. We rejoice in sharing the light of Christ, carrying our little lights to shine upon the whole world. We listen to the divine Word shining through our history of salvation, especially in light of the risen Lord. We make new Christians, baptizing, confirming them and they celebrate the eucharist with full participation and enjoy communion for the first time. For this reason, the church urges all the faithful to take part in the Triduum celebrations, and especially the Easter Vigil, the mother of all liturgies. Please come and join us for this momentous event.
- 3) Please come for the solemn Stations of the Cross on Good Friday evening, April 14th at 7pm. As well, you are invited to the Chrism Mass Tuesday evening of Holy Week at 7:30pm at the Cathedral. The diocese will mark the occasion with the jubilarians as main concelebrants. Two of our parishioners will receive the blessed oils consecrated at the chrism Mass for use here.
- 4) The Passion Readings on Palm Sunday and Good Friday are Gospel readings which require our attentive listening. We have assigned readers who serve the community to proclaim them. The assembly participate by active listening to the Liturgy of the Word.
- **5)** In the spirit of enhancing your participation at the Holy Week Services, I shall be giving a talk on the Meaning of the Easter Triduum on Saturday, April 8th (9:45 12 noon) in the Parish Hall. Come and join us in deepening our appreciation of the highlight of our liturgical season.
- **6)** We are having morning prayers on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday at 9am. Please come and pray the Psalms together, the Prayer of the Church!

7) At the request of the family, the funeral in the presence of ashes for Samuel Yachuk, a long-time parishioner, will be celebrated on Monday, April 10th at 9am. Regular devotions will end with Benediction at 8:30am. Please pray for the repose of his soul.
