1) **Third Sunday of Easter Reflection:** Jesus joined the two disciples as they walked to Emmaus. For a while they did not



know who he was, but their hearts burned within them as he interpreted the Scriptures, and, finally, they recognized him in the breaking of the bread. The same is true for us today. We meet him in the Sunday eucharist. He speaks to us in the word and he gathers us at table for "the breaking of the bread." Like the two disciples, do not our hearts burn within us? [National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165]

- 2) The ongoing widespread of the pandemic necessitates the churches to be completely shut and locked down for another few weeks at least. We shall keep you updated through our weekly post on the website. In the meantime, I urge you to be patient, keep a safe distance of at least two meters so as to prevent the strain on our health care, as well as ensure your own well-being. We hope everyone can cooperate so that we can quickly restore our regular worship and interaction.
- 3) As a result of the lock down the Parish Office is closed. Irene and June are working at home and messages are checked daily. Our maintenance team continue to maintain and disinfect the church as this is part of essential service.
- 4) After the busy time of preparing the live-stream Triduum services, we shall resume contact with you through weekly emails/parish bulletin and occasional phone calls!
- 5) We have engaged YouTube since before Holy Week, to livestream Masses, both weekdays and weekends. Those who have computer, cell phone or other electronic devices can benefit from it. Masses are live-streamed daily at 9:00am. Please connect via the parish website at www.fatimaparish.ca.
- 6) The Rite of Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion for our Elect Naga Lakshmi will be deferred to Pentecost Sunday. We hope by then there will be full participation of the faithful to welcome her as a disciple of Christ!
- 7) **Prayers for vocations: Third Sunday of Easter April 26:** For prayerful openness in our young people, that they will see their vocation discernment as a call to love the Lord and respond generously to His choice of them, we pray to the Lord.
- 8) I would like to express my sincere gratitude to all who give constructive and helpful comments after the daily live-stream services. Feedback is important as we seek to use modern technology to connect with parishioners at a time of social isolation. I would like to acknowledge those who contribute to facilitate ongoing contact with parishioners. Please be assured that you are close to my heart at daily Masses and prayers! If there is anything I can help with please know that I am only a phone call or e-mail away!
- 9) I would like to thank all those who continue to contribute financially to the parish. We hope that we can resume some form of normalcy soon! There are hopeful signs, but we still need to persevere and co-operate with self-isolation. You are in my prayers daily!
