1) Third Sunday of Easter
Reflection – Jesus joined the two
disciples as they walked to



Emmaus. For a while they didn't know who he was, but their hearts burned within them as he interpreted the Scriptures, and, finally, they recognized him in the breaking of the bread. The same is true for us today. We meet him in the Sunday Eucharist. He speaks to us in the word and he gathers us at table for the "breaking of the bread". Like the two disciples, do not our hearts burn within us? (National Bulletin Liturgy, vol. 33 #165)

- 2) Children will be celebrating their First Communion during the Easter Season. We shall be using the sprinkling rite instead of the Penitential Act at Mass throughout the Easter Season.
- 3) Throughout the Easter Season, we shall be using the blessing and sprinkling rite at our Masses as a reminder of our baptism, following the recommendation of the church. We place the holy water receptacle and paschal candle near the ambo to highlight this special liturgical season!
- 4) Do you know that according to the Church's Order The Rite of Christian Initiation, it is the entire parish community that is responsible for the initiation of new members? We begin the initiation process whenever they come to inquire about becoming Catholics. We embark on a process of discernment by welcoming them, introducing them to different parishioners and helping them discern if the Spirit calls them to become disciples of Christ. Members of the parish play different roles to support them. Please come to a workshop on Saturday, May 27th (9:45am-12:30pm) to understand this process. Please also invite those who are not baptized, but are interested in searching for meaning or are attracted to the Christian way of life to contact me or Fr. Tavis!
- 5) Fr. Ross Finlan, Administrator of St. Basil's, Sr. Sheila Finnerty, gsic, an expert of Adult Initiation and former Director of Liturgy for the Archdiocese and I shall be giving a workshop on Adult Initiation, including the initiation of Children who have reached catechetical age, following the Canonical Norms of the Diocese. This workshop will be held on Saturday, May 27th (9:45am-12:30pm). This is an opportunity to see how the entire parish community is involved in the initiation process.
- 6) Music in funeral liturgy: it is vitally important for families and friends of parishioners who attend funeral Masses at the church to pray for the deceased to join in the singing (the church encourages participation of the faithful by lifting up their voices). It is a gesture of hospitality to give people the hymn numbers and a cantor which enhances participation of the assembly.
- 7) Our sincere congratulations to Bernie and Shirley Hurley and family, who were chosen as family of the year in Ontario by the Knights of Columbus.
- 8) Members of our Finance Council will be making their oath of office at the 8:30am Mass on Sunday, May 7th, as required by the Diocesan Administration Manual.
