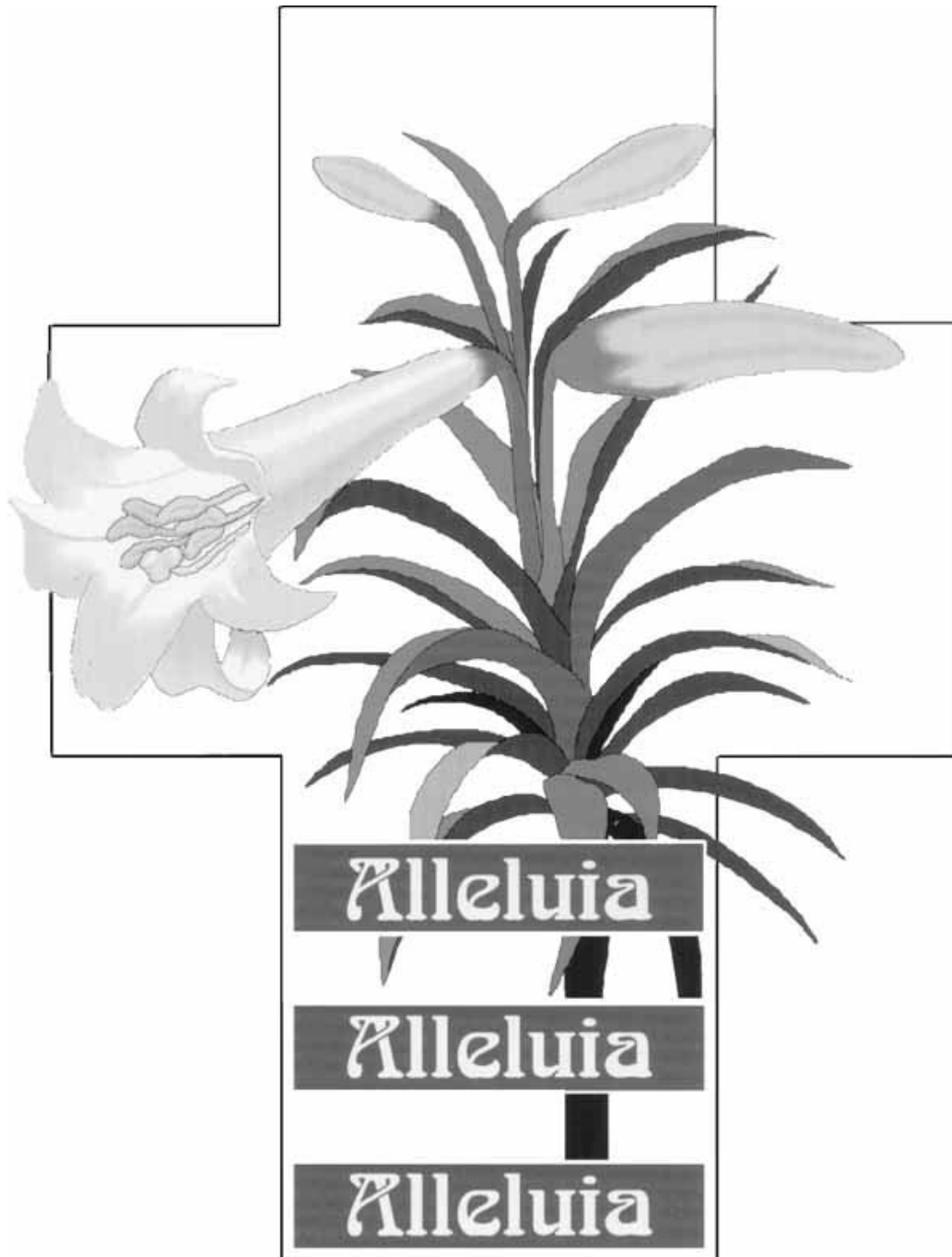

1) **Easter Reflection:** The resurrection of Jesus from the dead is the foundation of the Church’s proclamation of the good news of salvation. The risen Jesus was exalted at the right hand of God, and as Spirit-filled Lord he gathers the whole world into his own glorified humanity. This is the great mystery that we celebrate today and throughout the fifty days of Easter. This is the mystery that we share.[National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165]

2) Much **appreciation** to all concerned with the preparation and celebration of our parish liturgies during the Season of Lent and especially the Easter Triduum: **Music Ministers, Sacristans, Lectors, Extra-ordinary Ministers of Communion, Servers, Ushers, Decorators, Hospitality Ministers and the Co-ordinators of these ministries.** Many thanks also to those who facilitated the Triduum Morning Prayers.

3) Throughout the Easter Season, we shall be using the Blessing and Sprinkling Rite at our Masses as a reminder of our baptism, following the recommendation of the church’s general instruction. We place the holy water receptacle and pastoral candle near the ambo to highlight this special liturgical season.
