1) Much **appreciation** to all concerned with the preparation and celebration of Our Parish Liturgies during the Season of Lent and especially the Easter Triduum: **Music Ministers, Sacristans, Lectors, Extra-ordinary Ministers of Communion, Servers, Ushers, Decorators, Hospitality Ministers and the Co-ordinators of these ministries.**

2) Throughout the Easter Season, we shall be using the Blessing and Sprinkling Rite at our Masses as a reminder of our baptism, following the recommendation of the church's general instruction. We place the holy water receptacle and pastoral candle near the ambo to highlight this special liturgical season.
