1) During the Season of Lent, our faith community joins with Daryl McNiece in this season of renewal in our baptismal commitment. We shall use the Cycle A readings for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays of Lent for the 3 scrutinies. What are the scrutinies? Our Elect will make the resolve to scrutinize their lives, turning away from sin and embrace the way of life as followers of Christ, as the baptized are also called to Lenten Renewal during this joyful season as Disciples of Christ.

2) The Easter Triduum celebration marks the summit of our liturgical calendar. Please mark your calendar to participate in this three day celebration which starts with the Last Supper on Holy Thursday at 7:00pm., through the Friday Passion at 3:00pm and a special invitation is offered to **all parishioners and their friends** to participate in the great Easter Vigil, **the central and most beautiful liturgical celebration of the year.** We gather on **Saturday evening at 8:00pm to bless the paschal fire, to dedicate the paschal candle, to listen to the key stories of God's redemptive love.** Please plan to attend this great liturgy to show our support for our Elect at the Easter Vigil: Leah McNiece and Celia Cheung. Please pray for them as they seek to follow Our Lord Jesus Christ in their journey to complete their initiation and live the Christian way of life! Daryl McNiece will also complete his initiation through Confirmation and First Communion. A reception will be held after the Celebration!

3) On Holy Thursday after the post-communion prayer, the assembly will follow the procession to the Parish Hall for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. This is in the spirit of recognizing that we commemorate Christ's Paschal Mystery outside of our worship space. The hall will be "prepared and adorned" in such a way as to be conducive to prayer and meditation.

4) The Share Lent campaign for Development and Peace fosters peace in a world often torn by strife and violence. Today, on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, our special donation is for the cause of building peace, especially in areas where people suffer displacement and refugees seek safety and security for their families. Also, we have a special donation for the Holy Land on Good Friday, where there is great suffering for Christians.

5) Next Sunday is Palm Sunday. Please take a palm when you arrive at the church entrance. We shall bless and sprinkle the assembly and the palms at the early part of the liturgy!. We may gather outside the main church entrance, weather permitting.
