1) Passion (Palm) Sunday Reflection. Today's gospel is an account of the Passion of the Lord. The Passion signals the arrival of Holy Week and ushers in the last few days of our Lenten journey. Lent comes to a close when the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper begins. The time of preparation is almost over; the Easter Triduum is close at hand. As God's beloved people, let us use these last days well. And then, when they are over, let us celebrate the feast from beginning to end with all the spirit and power and joy that we possess. Let us make this year's feast the greatest spiritual event of our lives. (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165)

2) At the request of the family, the funeral for Samuel Yachuk will be celebrated on Monday, April 9th at 9am. Regular devotions will end with Benediction at 8:30am.

3) Why is it important to attend the Triduum celebrations? The Triduum (three days) celebrations mark the culmination of the Church's liturgical calendar. It marks the Lenten transition into the Easter Season. Beginning with the Last Supper after Sundown, when we introduce the oils blessed at the Chrism Mass by the bishop, to be used throughout the year; we commemorate Jesus celebrated the meal with the disciples, and urged them to serve one another in the foot washing; we transfer the Blessed Sacrament to be used on Good Friday to a place of repose. The first day ends with the Passion account from John, when we commemorate his death for us. We pray the solemn intercessions, venerate the cross and conclude with communion. On the second day, from Sundown of Good Friday to the time before Sundown, the church has no special liturgical celebration (except for the solemn devotion of the Stations of the Cross), but awaits through prayer and the elect prepares for their initiation. On nightfall of the third day, the church celebrates the joyful resurrection of the Lord. The fire is blessed, paschal candle is lit from the fire, marking Christ as light of the world. We rejoice in sharing the light of Christ, carrying our little lights to shine upon the whole world. We listen to the divine Word shining through our history of salvation, especially in light of the risen Lord. We make new Christians, baptizing, confirming them and they celebrate the eucharist with full participation and enjoy communion for the first time. For this reason, the church urges all the faithful to take part in the Triduum celebrations, and especially the Easter Vigil, the mother of all liturgies. Please come and join us for this momentous event.

4) On account of the special solemnity of the Last Supper (Holy Thursday) and the Easter Vigil, communion under both species will be available to all parishioners.

5) Please come for the solemn Stations of the Cross on Good Friday evening, April 11th at 7pm. As well, you are invited to the Chrism Mass Tuesday evening of Holy Week at 7:30pm at the Cathedral. The diocese will mark the occasion with the jubilarians as main concelebrants. Two of our parishioners will receive the blessed oils consecrated at the chrism Mass for use here.

6) The Passion Readings on Palm Sunday and Good Friday are Gospel readings which require our attentive listening. We have assigned readers who serve the community to proclaim them. The assembly participate by active listening to the Liturgy of the Word.

7) We are having morning prayers on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday at 9:00am. Please come and pray the Psalms together the Prayer of the Church.

8) Please note that **Good Friday** is a day of Fast and Abstinence.
