INTERESTED MINISTRY:	

1) One of the important roles as Pastor in a contemporary church is that of faith-community building, which echoes Pope Francis' ongoing summons to walk with the



faithful and encourage them to be missionary disciples, in other words, to follow Christ and give of ourselves in the way he directs us to live life to its fullness. Joyfully reaching out to others who worship with us, making sure if they are new, that we exercise hospitality and welcome them, and invite them to serve and minister to the community are essential components of living our discipleship.

- 2) We are having an anointing service during the 4:30 pm Mass on Sat. September 8. Here is what I put on the website to help you understand the sacrament of anointing: More commonly remembered as Anointing of the dying or remembered by many as the "Last Rite". It used to be administered to a dying person, even after she/he died, known as conditional anointing. It is now more commonly given to someone who has a grave illness, or is about to be admitted to hospital for major surgery. The church accompanies them at this time of trial by the sacrament which strengthens them and casts away their fear, knowing that the Spirit of the Lord will be with them and bring them peace. The sacrament can be repeated when the person recovers and later faces another health crisis. In fact, the sacrament is often administered in nursing homes or even in parishes regularly for those who are elderly, frail or others who have serious health challenges. As sacraments are for the living, the anointing sacrament is not given to someone who is already dead. Should the family request a priest, he goes to pray with them and ask God's loving mercy upon the deceased and give consolation to the family at this trying time as they face the death of a loved one. Family members who call for the anointing should be present when the priest anoints their loved one, to ensure that they witness the anointing and do not feel anxious about whether or not the sacrament has been celebrated. The ritual of anointing includes prayers that are uplifting and shows the supportive presence of the church, not to hasten the death but to accompany the sick with God's loving consolation at his/her time of trial. It is therefore not necessary to wait until death is imminent for the sacrament to be administered.
- 3) It was brought to my attention that we have parishioners who can no longer serve as Lectors and Eucharistic ministers. If you are not yet involved in any ministry, why not consider exercising your talents and gifts so as to build up the Body of Christ!
- 4) Kendra Oatway, baptized in another Christian Church, wishes to become a Catholic. She has journeyed with our community for some time. She has been dismissed regularly at the 11:30 am Masses to reflect on the Word of God with a Catechist. She will be received into the Church on Sunday, August 26 at the 11:30 am Mass through profession of faith, confirmation and first communion. Please join her and her sponsor to give thanks to God for this grace of her reception.
- **5)** Funerals that were celebrated here in August:: Margaret Sandiford (August 2nd), and Pierette Malette (August 11th). Parishioners are always invited to attend funeral Masses to give support and consolation to the grieving families in our parish community.
