Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to "come follow me," to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.

1) Concerns were expressed by the volunteer sacristans that the candles behind the tabernacles are too heavy to be



changed and lit. As of the First Sunday of Advent, those candles will only be lit for weekend Masses to bring out the importance of Sunday Mass over weekdays.

- 2) Please refer to your copy of the Advent-Christmas pamphlet, along with meal prayers, highlighting the liturgies of the Season for your reference. This pamphlet can also be found on our parish website. You can also pick up a copy of Pope Francis' words on Advent meditation for your perusal. We have a limited quantity of these booklets available on the table near the main Church Entrance.
- 3) At the last Pastoral Council, it was unanimously agreed that in conjunction with the diocesan vision and Pope Francis' call for missionary discipleship, it would be important to exercise our hospitality in greeting one another before we begin our worship. We are not merely unconnected individuals who worship God, but rather we gather as a community of faith, realizing that the Real Presence of Christ is present in the Assembly gathered in His Name for Mass which is the source and summit of Christian life!
- 4) We have made available copies of the Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel. Parishioners are encouraged to pray this devotional prayer, particularly for protection of the Church and all members against evil and work towards individual holiness. You may take it home as a prayer tool as you see fit, at the adoration time before Mass during weekdays, or should you arrive at church earlier to pray over the weekend.
- 5) My mother passed away to the Lord last week. I shall be celebrating her funeral Mass and attend to matters in Hong Kong. I am grateful to Fr. Ross Finlan, a retired priest of our diocese, who has accepted to fill in for me in my absence. I hope to get back as soon as a flight is available the week of Jan. 7.
- 6) On behalf of the parish staff, I wish you all a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year filled with divine Blessings!
