1) Christmas Reflection.
Christmas is a popular festival.
Commercial hype and the



vaguely religious figure of Santa Claus make sure of that. But we are a community of faith, and we know that Christmas is all about the birth of the Lord. For us, what really counts is the Christmas mass (Christmas – Christmass). We don't come together merely to listen to lovely music or to watch a splendid ritual. We come together to meet the Lord, who is God's great gift to the world, and to welcome him into our lives. [National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165]

**2)** It is not often that Christmas Day coincides with Sunday – whenever this happens we shall celebrate the Holy Family on Friday, Dec. 30<sup>th</sup>, and Epiphany Sunday on January 8<sup>th</sup>, with the Baptism of the Lord on the following Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. This feast day will conclude the liturgical Season of Christmas.

Please also note that our Christmas Eve Masses are 4:30pm, 7:00pm and 10:00pm. As well, we have Masses at 10:00am and 11:30am on Christmas Day. Also, our New Year's Masses are the same as regular Sunday Mass schedules.
