- 2) The way we initiate Christians is how we celebrate and live our discipleship, how we connect and encounter the person of Christ in our lives. As Fr. James Mallon indicates in his book. Divine Renovation: from a Maintenance to a Missional Parish, "It is most often not a wilful reduction of faith to simple knowledge about Jesus, but a lack of awareness that it is even possible to know him and to be known and loved personally by him. The fact that so many Catholics are utterly convinced that they are missing nothing shows that the weekly experience of faith and "religion" acts as a kind of vaccine to the full power of the Christian faith. Many who are no longer held in the clutches of duty, guilt or fear, walk away rejecting a hollow version of the real thing. As a result, we have all too often capitulated as leaders and formed pastoral methodologies designed to feed those who have no hunger. We give in to pressure from distracted and bored parishioners to preach shorter and shorter homilies, aware that many would be quite pleased if we just dispensed with the whole thing completely and got to the communion bit so that the mad dash to the parking lot could commence." (p. 23)
- Following Fr. Terrence Fournier's talk on liturgy and devotions, we understand that all devotions lead to better participation at our liturgy. For further reference, refer to: "Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy: Principles and Guidelines," from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, with address by Pope John Paul II, December 2001. Beginning in Advent, the beginning of the Liturgical Year, we shall not have Adoration and Benediction on a daily basis. We shall instead give people the opportunity for quiet devotion before the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle every day from 8 to 8:45am, preparing ourselves for participation at Mass. However, we shall have Adoration and Benediction on the First Friday of every month. Another difficulty of having Adoration and Benediction every day is in getting volunteers to shoulder the responsibility. Also, when people come late for confession, Benediction gets delayed and people ae walking in for Mass in the midst of the blessing, not a proper setting for giving reverence at Benediction.
- 4) I urge parents who are preparing their children for the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion to bring their children to Church. Sacraments are meaningful encounters with Christ who calls us to make the Lord's Day Holy, by gathering to give praise and thanksgiving to God.
- Enclosed with last weekend's bulletin was an Advent-Christmas pamphlet, along with meal prayers, highlighting the liturgies of the Season for your reference. You will also find this pamphlet on our parish website. You can also pick up a copy of Pope Francis' words on Advent Meditation for your perusal. We have a limited quantity of these booklets available on the table near the main Church entrance.
