It is intended to open our hearts to God and others and to be a means of purification and spiritual liberation and a witness to the depth of our faith. The Way of the Cross will be prayed at 8:00am. Ashes will be distributed at the 9:00am, 4:30pm and 7:00pm Masses. Please note that on Ash Wednesday, February 14th, there will be a 7:00pm Mass.

1) How do we live our missionary discipleship? We have a few inquirers (people seeking to become Catholics)



who have begun to walk the journey of faith in our parish. They would be ready to be introduced to the community through the Rite of Acceptance to become Catechumens. During the catechumenate they will join us every Sunday for Mass, however, after the homily they will be sent out with a Catechist to continue to reflect on and pray with the Scriptures, until such time as they will be able to receive the Lord at communion and live as disciples of Christ. We are looking for a number of Lectors and other parishioners who are able to lead this reflection and prayer during Mass. Sr. Sheila Finnerty, GSIC, has graciously accepted to take these volunteers through the process of Gospel reflection. This will take place on Saturday March 3rd at 10-11:30am. A reminder that the task of initiating new members belongs to all the baptized!

- 2) "LITURGY MOMENT: The General Instruction of Liturgy GIRM, 85: "It is most desirable that the faithful, just as the priest himself is bound to do, receive the Lord's body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass and that, in the instances when it is permitted, they partake of the chalice, so that even by means of signs Communion will stand out more clearly as a participation in the sacrifice actually being celebrated." No instruction is given about going to the tabernacle... We do not go to the fridge at home to find left-over food to mix with what is freshly prepared. Why do we do so for the Eucharist? "This is not to infer that the body of Christ is "leftovers" and not validly the Eucharist. What the General Instruction and our theology of the Mass emphasize is that we are participating in the Order of Mass for a reason, that the sacrifice, the blessing, breaking, and sharing of the Eucharistic elements, and the change both in the gifts and in us should be "in the moment," and not held over from another time. We can undermine the power of the liturgical action itself, even unwittingly, by perpetuating certain habits and long-established practices." See Emmanuel: Pastoral Liturgy, May/June 2017, p. 184-5.
- 3) We begin the Season of Lent this coming Ash Wednesday, a day of Fast and Abstinence. Enclosed in this bulletin is the Archbishop's Lenten Message. You can also pick up a copy of a booklet by Fr. Thomas Connery, *Joyful Steps: Daily Lenten Devotions* for personal prayer and meditation.
- 4) Our community includes many elderly parishioners. We shall do our best to inform parishioners whenever there is a death in the parish family. We encourage you to come and give support and consolation to the family whenever there is a funeral, as the choir and altar servers do showing their support and prayers. This is part of faith community-building!
