1) Reflection for the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time: According to the law in Leviticus, those who have



leprous disease are humiliated to the point of a miserable existence (like a death sentence) and are treated as outcasts. Out of desperation, the leper in the Gospel encountered Jesus and was healed. He was transformed from brokenness to wholeness, from despair to hope, from death to life!

- 2) To enhance communication with our parishioners, especially during the pandemic, the Archdiocese encourages parishes to introduce Flocknote, an electronic tool to keep you informed. It is free for participating parishioners. Parishes will pay a monthly fee. Those who sign up will be able to receive bulletins and other news directly to email or text. See the notice elsewhere in this bulletin.
- 3) After Christmas, the province locked down our worship space in order to control the pandemic. Please note that should anyone wish to receive reconciliation, please contact me at pastering-reconstruct or by phone 613-722-7661x3.
- 4) The Premier of Ontario has announced that the lockdown in Ottawa will be lifted as of Tuesday, February 16, provided the daily downward trend continues. Assuming we can return to 30% attendance, we shall plan **Ash Wednesday** accordingly. We anticipate having two Masses on February 17 at 9am and 4:30pm. Parishioners can call the parish office or me to register, use email or flocknote to reserve a place, on a first come, first serve basis.
- 5) For imposition of Ashes with safety in mind, we shall follow the practice recommended by the Diocese. I shall bless the ashes at the communion railing at the usual time after the homily, I remind you to "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Good News." You answer collectively: Amen! Ashes will only be administered at the end of the Mass as you exit. I shall put the mask on and sprinkle ashes over your head (please bow your head slightly to make it easier to reach!). No words will be exchanged. Your safety is my priority.
- 7) Please follow all safety protocols and stay healthy!
