How do we live our missionary discipleship? We have a few inquirers who have begun to walk the journey of



faith in our parish for a little while. They would be ready during the Easter Season to celebrate the Rite of Acceptance to become Catechumens when they are introduced to the community and signed with the Cross at the senses. At that time they will be sent to another place where a Catechist will accompany them to be further nourished in the Gospel way of life, until such time as they will be able to receive the Lord and live as disciples of Christ. We are looking for a number of Lectors and other parishioners who are able to welcome them through this process during Mass. Sr. Sheila Finnerty has graciously accepted to help these volunteers through this time of Gospel reflection on **Saturday March 3rd at 10-11:30am.** A reminder that the task of initiating new members belongs to all the baptized!

2) "LITURGY MOMENT: - The General Instruction of Liturgy GIRM, 85: "It is most desirable that the faithful, just as the priest himself is bound to do, receive the Lord's body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass and that, in the instances when it is permitted, they partake of the chalice, so that even by means of the signs, Communion will stand out more clearly as a participation in the sacrifice actually being celebrated." No instruction is given about going to the tabernacle.

"What the General Instruction and our theology of the Mass emphasize is that we are participating in the Order of Mass for a reason, that the sacrifice, the blessing, breaking, and sharing of the Eucharistic elements, and the change both in the gifts and in us should be "in the moment," and not held over from another time. We can undermine the power of the liturgical action itself, even unwittingly, by perpetuating certain habits and long-established practices." See *Emmanuel: Pastoral Liturgy, May/June 2017, p. 184-5.*

- 3) We began the Season of Lent on Ash Wednesday. Enclosed in last Sunday's bulletin was the Archbishop's Lenten Message and also the Lent-Easter liturgical schedule. A copy of the schedule can also be found on our website. You can also pick up a copy of a Lenten reflection for personal prayer and meditation on the table near the main church entrance.
- 4) This year, to help us reflect upon our missionary discipleship, I shall give an hourly Lenten mission each evening of March 5, 6 and 7 starting at 7pm. The themes of reflection will be focused on Lenten Joy: Mon Joy of being Christians; Tues Joy of Christian Families; and Wed Joy of God's Mercy and Forgiveness, followed by communal and individual reconciliation.
