**UPDATE ON REFUGEE CAMPAIGN:** This week marks the first year anniversary of the arrival of Our Lady of Fatima's sponsored Syrian Family. At the time they heard that they had been selected to come to Canada, our family had been living for several years as displaced persons in



Lebanon with no prospects of being able to return to their war torn country. Mum, Dad and two small children arrived in Ottawa on a very cold winter morning speaking no English or French with all of their possessions in a few small suitcases. From the moment the family arrived, they were engulfed in the warmth and fellowship of this Parish. Many parishioners donated money, clothing and furniture to help them establish their home. Others gave of their time, helping them at the bank, taking them to shopping and to medical appointments, helping them get bus passes to go to English classes, engaging them in social activities and, overall, fostering the crossing of cultural bridges. Now, after one year in Ottawa, the prospects for the family are very bright. Their son is doing well in Our Lady of Fatima School and his sister will be following him in another year. Dad has been working almost since his arrival here while also juggling English classes. And most excitingly, the family has been blessed by the birth of a new baby born just before Christmas. While the official period of sponsorship is over, our Parish will continue to work with the family to help ensure their success here in Canada. Our family's great success in integrating into our community is directly attributable to the selfless acts of fellowship and generosity displayed by our parishioners and is a testament to our prayers and the enduring work of the Holy Spirit. The generous monetary donations from parishioners has allowed the Parish to continue with further refugee and social justice works. Stay tuned over coming months for further announcements.

1) As a result of the liturgical workshop and the input of the liturgy committee, we are using the Gospel Book in the liturgical



the Gospel Book in the liturgical procession, highlighting the importance of the Gospel in the Liturgy of the Word. Beginning with the First Sunday of Lent, a reader will carry the Book of the Gospel at the entrance procession, she/he will put it on the main Altar, then at the Alleluia, the priest will pick up the Gospel Book, preceded by the servers, move to lay it on the Ambo, then proclaim the Gospel. The Lectionary will be laid on the ambo at the beginning of Mass, then after a silent pause at the conclusion of the Epistle Reading, he/she will set it reverently at a table nearby. There will not, however, be a procession of the Gospel Book at the end of Mass.

- 2) In conformity with the Roman Missal, we shall consecrate most of the hosts to be used for the particular Mass. We shall go to the tabernacle only if and when we run short.
