pandemic echoes Job's sentiment
in today's first reading, we feel



in today's first reading, we feel helpless and wonder when everything will be back to normal. Our faith in the healing power of Christ gives us reason for hope in the midst of darkness and despair. In addition to this, many people in different parts of the world face unrest and violence: Myanmar and Russia among others. We pray that God will grant us strength and courage to cope, especially for these suffering people.

- 2) The province has locked down our worship space in order to control the pandemic. During the lockdown, I shall continue to celebrate Mass daily at 9am, rain or shine. If you wish to participate, go to the parish website and click on the red button!
- 3) Further restrictions from the province: Message from the Chancellor in regard to the Second Provincial Emergency to Address COVID-19:

The stay-at-home order requires everyone to remain at home with exceptions for essential purposes. It will last 28 days and can be extended. Starting January 14, religious services (includes Mass), weddings and funerals will be limited to 10 people indoors or outdoors with physical distancing and compliance with rules on face coverings as long as we are in a Provincial Emergency. Even for these smaller services the COVID-19 protocols need to be observed. Parishes are strongly encouraged to livestream Masses during the Provincial Emergency.

- 4) To enhance communication with our parishioners, especially during the pandemic, the Archdiocese encourages parishes to introduce Flocknote, an electronic tool to keep you informed. It is free for participating parishioners. Parishes will pay a monthly fee. Those who sign up will be able to receive bulletins and other news directly to email or text. See the notice elsewhere in this bulletin.
- 5) Ash Wednesday is February 17th and marks the beginning of Lent. As the number of local cases in Ottawa is on a downward trend, I hope that the lockdown will be eased up in a few days. I shall update you on any changes to our worship schedule through our website, flocknote and the bulletin as soon as details are available stay tuned!
- 6) Please ensure you follow all safety protocols and stay healthy!


