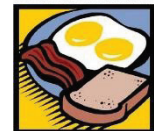

LRT UPDATE: REVISED PARKING REGULATIONS APPROVED: The City of Ottawa has approved weekend parking regulations on the south side of Knightsbridge and the west side of Lockhart. The signage confirming these changes was installed during the month of October 2018. Both alternative sources of off-site parking will help to offset the eventual loss of roadway parking on Byron between Lockhart and Woodroffe.
