- 1) As a result of the liturgical workshop and the input of the liturgy committee, we are using the Gospel Book in the liturgical procession, highlighting the importance of the Gospel in the Liturgy of the Word. Beginning with the First Sunday of Lent, a reader will carry the Book of the Gospel at the entrance procession, she/he will put it on the main Altar, then at the Alleluia, the priest will pick up the Gospel Book, preceded by the servers, move to lay it on the Ambo, then proclaim the Gospel. The Lectionary will be laid on the ambo at the beginning of Mass, then after a silent pause at the conclusion of the Epistle Reading, he/she will set it reverently at a table nearby. There will not, however, be a procession of the Gospel Book at the end of Mass.
 - 2) In conformity with the Roman Missal, we shall consecrate most of the hosts to be used for the particular Mass. We shall go to the tabernacle only if and when we run short.
 - 3) Tour to China: A 19-day Winter Get-away to China. The journey covers the Great Wall, Terra Cotta Warrior, Yangtze River Cruise, Panda Zoo, Guilin, Hong Kong.  - 4) This year marks the 70th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima Parish and this is a perfect opportunity to once again create a Photo Directory as we did in 1997 and 2007. Bishop Christian remarked how wonderful it is for our young people to be confirmed in the presence of a prayerful parish community!
 - 6) A number of infants were baptized last weekend, including one who was baptized during our regular Sunday Mass, in the presence of our faith community. May we as members of the Christian family continue to give the parents and godparents prayerful support.
 - 7) I am away on a pilgrimage in Fatima and Lourdes. I shall be back on Saturday, February 25th.
