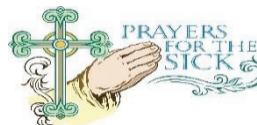

1) 7th Sunday in Ordinary

Time: Jesus gives us a more exalted norm of ethics: “Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you”. Living the beatitudes in a radical manner is the way of the reign of God which Jesus challenges us, his followers!

2) This coming Wednesday Feb.26 is Ash Wednesday, the day when we come together as a parish family to begin our Lenten renewal. **What is Ash Wednesday all about?** It is the time when we begin our journey to the great three-day festival of Jesus' death and resurrection, the celebration that is the heart and centre of the Church's liturgical year. We call this feast the Paschal or Easter Triduum (a triduum meaning a period of three days) or the Passover of the Lord.

3) Ash Wednesday Morning Mass will be at 9:00am (children from Our Lady of Fatima School will join us). We shall also have Wednesday Mass with Perpetual Help Devotions at 4:30pm as well as at 7:00pm Mass for your participation. All Masses will include imposition of ashes. I shall also impose ashes upon the Community of Dr. F. J. McDonald School during a Liturgy of the Word at 12:30pm.

4) The readings of Ash Wednesday are a clarion call to assemble as a people, a solemn announcement that this Lent is the favorable time of grace, a summons to prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The words that accompany the imposition of ashes are a fine summary of our Lenten undertaking as a people: “Turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel”. Ash Wednesday is a universal day of fast (between ages 18-59) and abstinence from meat. Let us give our Lenten discipline a strong start. Let us begin to put our house in order so that we will be spiritually ready for the greatest feast of the entire Church year. (National Bulletin of Liturgy, vol. 33 #165). The diocese also requests that we abstain from meat on other Lenten Fridays so as to facilitate our union with the Cross of Christ and his self-offering.

5) Included with this bulletin is a pamphlet of the Lent-Easter Liturgical Schedule which will also be found on our website. Please keep it for reference.

6) Copies of the Archbishop's Lenten Message are available at the main entrance of the church as well as the parish website. You can also pick up a copy of a booklet **Lent with the Saints: Wisdom from the Church's Holy Ones** for personal prayer and meditation.

7) The recent widespread of coronavirus (no case as yet in Ottawa) and flu season compels us to be prudent in frequent hand-washing after shaking hands and avoid sharing the Communion cup if we have flu-like symptoms in consideration for others. We continue to make available Communion in both species, as preferred by the Liturgical Norms of the Church. It is always the personal discretion of parishioners whether to receive from the cup. Should the situation call for greater prudence in preventing the spread of germs, we shall adjust accordingly!

8) Prayers for vocation for the 7th Sunday of Ordinary Time: For perseverance in sincere prayer on the part of the faithful, asking the Lord for holy vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life, we pray to the Lord. **Ash Wednesday – February 26** – that men and women will answer the call of their vocations, denying themselves, taking up their crosses, and following Christ, we pray to the Lord.
