1) Reflection for Baptism of the Lord: The Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist marks the beginning of his ministry. The



affirmation of his identity as the Beloved Son of God and the descent of the Spirit upon him at his baptism mark the inauguration of a new era. His mission entails healing human brokenness and restoring to wholeness. We are called to participate in his mission by virtue of our own baptism and in forming disciples. Even in this challenging time of the lockdown, we are called to stay safe and do our part to ensure the safety of others, especially the vulnerable and elderly!

- 2) A note of appreciation to all those involved in liturgies during the Advent and Christmas Season, especially with the challenges posed by the pandemic. Thank you to all those who helped with contact tracing, sanitizing, bringing people to their seats, our music ministers Peter and John, Liturgical decorations for the Christmas Season, Ministers of Communion and Lectors.
- 3) The province has locked down our worship space since December 26 in order to control the pandemic. During the lockdown, I shall continue to celebrate Mass daily at 9am, rain or shine. If you wish to participate, go to the parish website and click on the red button!
- 4) With the baptism of the Lord we conclude the Season of Christmas. Normally on the feast of Epiphany we announce from the ambo the moveable feasts of the current year according to this formula: (see Appendix I, p. 1440 of the Roman Missal). Know, dear brothers and sisters, that as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior. On the 17th day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the 4th day of April, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ will be celebrated on May 16th. On the 23rd day of May, the feast of Pentecost. On the 6th day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the 28th day of November, the First Sunday of Advent of Our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.


