INTERESTED MINISTRY:	

1) How do we live our missionary discipleship? In his book, *From Maintenance to Mission: Evangelization and* 



the Revitalization of the Parish, Robert Rivers (Paulist Press, 2005), urges parishes to focus our attention on mission to the world, rather than maintenance oriented (directed all our resources to people in church, p. 38). He also wants us to be active disciples, not simply consumers. This consumer attitude is based on a mentality where the goal of every good Catholic is getting to heaven: by being in church every Sunday, going to regular confession, avoiding grave sins. There is little concern for the baptismal call to share actively in the mission and ministry of Jesus as our way into the kingdom. The author continues, "as long as Catholics view baptism as an entitlement rather than a call to active discipleship, our parishes will continue to be fundamentally maintenance-oriented service stations that only take care of the needs of their own." (p.39)— This is fruit for thought!

- 2) Exercising our missionary discipleship when it comes to baptism of infants: parishioners recognize that since baptism is the first and most important sacrament in one's life, it is vitally important for the Christian Community to be present, to give prayerful support to the parents and godparents, while welcoming them to continue to worship with us and celebrate their belonging in the faith community. For this reason, the Ritual of Baptism clearly endorses the practice of baptizing infants within the assembly gathered at Sunday Mass. Rather than seeing it as a problem, we should embrace the chance of welcoming the families and live our discipleship!
- 3) LITURGY MOMENT Two different persons to proclaim first and second readings. As Lectors are vehicles through which the Real Presence of Christ in the Word is proclaimed to the assembly, it would be better to have two different readers with varying tones of voices to make it more effective. When only one reader is present at Mass, a second reading can be proclaimed by a commentator or another suitable reader. The General Instruction #109 states: "if there are several readings, it is well to distribute them among a number of readers." Also, in the pastoral notes for the instruction, the Canadian Bishops state in #161 "different readers should proclaim the different readings, since each reading requires its own kind of preparation and presentation. The change in voice and style brought by separate lectors better maintains the assembly's attention." In the same paragraph is stated: "Missalettes or other materials containing the printed text have no place within the celebration. Only people who have trouble hearing or understanding the lector should use missalettes."
- 4) Let us continue to give prayerful support to the children who were enrolled for First Communion last Sunday during the 11:30am Mass. The actual celebration will happen during a Mass of the Easter Season, chosen by the family.
