With this in mind, we may say that every Sunday Eucharist is a new epiphany of the Lord. As a community that shares the wisdom that comes from God, we come together on the Lord's Day and publicly proclaim the lordship of Jesus Christ. Our gift is the gift of our lives for the glory of God.


