1) **Feast of Baptism of the Lord.** Jesus, who took upon our human condition and identified with us except for sin, was baptized by John the Baptist. His baptism inaugurates his ministry as one who brings us to be redeemed and saved. 2) Our liturgical season of Christmas concludes this weekend as we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord on January 11-12. Christmas decorations will be taken down as we begin Ordinary Time after this weekend.

STAGE 2 LRT: NOTIFICATION CONCERNING FUTURE BLASTING.

The City of Ottawa and its sub-contractor, DST Consulting Engineers, have notified landowners and residents that blasting will be required as part of Stage 2 LRT. The Parish will be procuring the professional services of an independent engineering firm to document the physical status of the Church and its annexes. This investment will serve the Parish well should any structural damage result from blasting activities. No date has been communicated to the Parish for the commencement of blasting in the Byron Linear Park.
