“THE WAY WE WORSHIP IS THE WAY WE BELIEVE”: Last Saturday over 50 people attended the workshop on the New Roman Missal which came into effect in November 2011. Fr. Bosco Wong highlighted some of the guidelines for liturgical practices set out in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal in order for us to gain a better understanding of why we do what we do during Mass as we gather together as a community of the faithful. Fr. Bosco used humor and examples as he touched on many topics ranging from choice of hymns to the use of low gluten hosts. In view of the fact that these guidelines have now been in force for over five years, we will implement necessary changes to our current practices in the near future, in consultation with the liturgy committee. The workshop was an excellent opportunity to learn more about the way we worship – thanks to all who attended!

1) Baptism during Mass: Just as anointing of the sick during the Community gathering in worship, the Baptism of infants is more and more frequently being celebrated during Sunday Mass. According to the “Rite of Baptism for Children,” #9: “To bring out the paschal character of baptism, it is recommended that the sacrament be celebrated during the Easter Vigil or on Sunday, when the Church commemorates the Lord’s resurrection. On Sunday, baptism may be celebrated even during Mass. So that the entire community may be present and the relationship between baptism and Eucharist may be clearly seen.” It is therefore appropriate that the community signs the child after the parents and godparents do so. The community also pledge to support them in their task of bringing the child to the Christian community and pray for the child at the prayer of the faithful. The sacrament is not only for the good of the infant, it is a grace to the whole parish. The child held in the arms of its loving father or mother is an effective sign of who we are before God. “Amen, I say to do, whoever does not accept the Kingdom of God like a child will not enter it” (Luke 18:17). I hope to introduce some infant baptisms during our Sunday Masses, especially for the families who are connected with our parish, so that the community will rejoice together with our parish families with the newly born child.

2) The church requires the hosts used for communion contain gluten for validity, many of those who are intolerant to gluten, however, cannot tolerate even the low gluten hosts. For this reason, we shall gradually phase out the gluten-free hosts. I have directed those who are intolerant to gluten to a procedure of receiving the precious blood, which will be made available to them. Please consult with me or Fr. Goski should you wish to do so.

3) We are replacing the Holy Is The Lord hymnal with Music Issue, which will be made available to you. The latter has an abundance of appropriate liturgical hymns conducive to worship.

4) I would like to thank the parishioners who attended the liturgical workshop last Saturday. Those who attended express appreciation that it helped them gain a deeper understanding of our worship.

5) I am keenly interested in meeting with you, if only briefly, at the end of Mass, to greet you and get to know you a little better. If at all possible, I would invite you to give me an opportunity to arrive at the entrance of the church before you leave. As St. Paul says, “we are members of one another in Christ as a Eucharistic assembly”. It is also courtesy to other parishioners and to the priest that we wait until after the final blessing to leave the church. (I do recognize that there are good and valid reasons for parishioners to leave early because of bus schedules or personal situations, but I also ask those who are able, to make an effort to remain until the end of Mass). Thank you!
