PARISH OFFICE: The Parish Office is now open on Monday and Tuesday from 9am-3pm, and on Wednesday from 9am-1pm. Visitors are not permitted inside the Office but we are happy to serve you through the window. Please use the Lobby entrance and follow the directional signs: up the steps to Library, then turn right to get to Office; down the ramp when leaving the Office. PLEASE ARRIVE BEFORE MASS BEGINS: as a courtesy to the Hospitality Ministers. They have difficulty participating in the Mass if you arrive late or at the last minute, as they need to seat you, do sanitizing and contact tracing. During the Liturgy of the Word you will be asked to wait at the entrance until the liturgical action is finished. Thank you for your co-operation.

NEW SUNDAY MISSALS 2020-2021: are now available for purchase in the Parish Office or at the Church Attendance Desk, \$5 each. Exact change only please.

ENVELOPE BOXES 2021: are now available. This year we will not place name labels on the boxes. Please pick up a blank box on your way out of Mass. Boxes will be left near each of the two exit doors. This means you will have a new envelope number for 2021. If for some reason you prefer to keep your current envelope number, please contact the Office and we will do our best to put that box aside for you. Using our envelopes ensures you will receive a tax receipt. Here are a few tips to make sure your contributions are accurately recorded: 1) As of January 1, 2021 please discard any envelopes from previous years. 2) For the first

few contributions of the year please clearly print your name/address on the envelope, as well as the amount of the donation. After that please print your name and the donation amount. Better yet, attach a pre-printed address label if you have them! Thank you for your continued support.

YOUR CONTINUED SUPPORT IS APPRECIATED. Did you know our parish depends exclusively on the on-going generosity of donations to maintain our operations? As we do our part to help prevent the spreading of COVID19, please consider how you can continue your financial support. WHY DO I NEED TO SIGN IN AT MASS? Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. **This is for your protection so that they can contact you if necessary.** Please sanitize your hands and look for your LAST NAME on the list, then place a checkmark beside your name. If you cannot find your name please print it on the blank sheet provided, along with your phone number. The usher will then guide you to your seat. Records will be kept private and destroyed after 30 days. Many thanks for your patience and co-operation!

SCHEDULING A MASS INTENTION: If you would like to schedule an intention please mail your request with your offering, or drop it in the Rectory mail slot (front door opposite Funeral Home). Requests can also be made by phone or e-mail. Payment can be made by credit card or cheque. The suggested donation for an announced Mass intention is \$15. If you have already booked an intention but have not yet made your offering please make arrangements to do so before the scheduled date so that you can be sure the intention will be prayed for.
