MASKS REQUIRED BY ALL ATTENDING MASS

Archbishop Damphousse has notified all parishes that, as of Monday, January 17, every person over the age of 2 who attends Mass is required to wear a face mask. Medical exemptions from wearing a mask at Mass will no longer be accepted. A face shield will not be considered an acceptable substitute for a mask.

He recognizes that no one enjoys wearing a mask for an hour but draws attention to the front-line workers in the service industries who wear a mask their entire workday as a sacrifice for the safety of customers. The act of wearing a mask for the duration of Mass is an act of charity toward our neighbour and he encourages us to see it in that light.

Celebrants and lectors may remove their mask only when they are sufficiently distanced from the assembly (by at least two meters) in order to read or preside.

He encourages everyone to be vaccinated and receive the boosters when they become available but is not planning to restrict Mass attendance to only those who are vaccinated. Holy Communion is to be given only in the hand.

BEWARE OF EMAIL SCAMS FROM SOMEONE PRETENDING TO BE A PRIEST: asking for money, gift cards or other services. Scams often use the priest's name but with a strange address and the message itself often does sound like the priest you know. Exercise caution whenever you receive an email from anyone you know that sounds suspicious. If in doubt, contact the priest using the parish's email or phone number. Please be cautious. The scams are becoming more sophisticated.

INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SYNOD ON SYNODALITY AT FATIMA

Pope Francis initiated a synodal journey of the whole People of God, beginning in each local parish and culminating in an assembly of the bishops in Rome. The theme of this synod is about what it is to be a Church; the specific way of living and operating as a Church together.

What is a synod? A synod is simply a gathering or assembly of bishops. But the process for this synod begins as gatherings of ordinary people at the parish level. We are going to create an opportunity for listening to one another (listening session) and to what the Holy Spirit may be saying to us about our Church at this time (discerning session). The fruits of our gathering will then be sent to the Archdiocese, which will make a summary report from all the participating parishes. Eventually reports from across the world end up in Rome in preparation for the synod of bishops in October 2023. We are hopeful that this process of listening and discerning also contributes to the sense of communion within our own parish.

How do I participate? We will be holding sessions to which you are invited to participate. If numbers permit, we will be holding sessions for two separate groups. For one group there will be a listening session on **Tuesday, March 29** and a discerning session on **Tuesday, April 5**. For a separate group there will be a listening session on **Thursday, March 31** and a discerning session on **Thursday, April 7**. All sessions will begin at **7:00pm** and last 90 minutes. If feasible they will be held in the Parish Hall, otherwise they will be held on Zoom.
