JOYFUL NEWS - MASSES HAVE RESUMED! Our Mass times in July are: Monday-Friday 9am, Saturday 4:30pm, Sunday 8:30am, 10am, 11:30am.

We encourage everyone to adhere to the Ottawa Public Health guidelines - if you are 65 and older, have a chronic condition or have a compromised immune system you may be at higher risk of developing complications. Please remember that **Sunday obligation is suspended until further notice** so it is not mandatory that you return to Mass at this time. Please stay safe. You might prefer attending a weekday Mass where it is less crowded. Or watch the Mass livestreamed at 11:30am on Sunday.

Things will be different. You will notice many changes when you return. **We want to keep each other safe.** Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to <u>please stay home</u> if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. Please follow their instructions and do not move from your assigned spot. 1) Reflection on the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Solomon chose wisdom over wealth, and God grants him the



grace of discerning what is pleasing to God! In the Gospel, Jesus calls all his disciples to discern the Kingdom of Heaven as the most precious treasure.

- 2) **Reflection on the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Seeking the priceless nourishment provided by our gracious God. The multiplication of loaves and fish is the sign of God's ongoing nourishment for us, who calls us also to be bread for one another in Christ!
- 3) As of July 7th, the Province has made it mandatory to wear a mask/face covering so as to reduce transmission of COVID19. The policy is to ensure that we shall not have a second wave which could set us back. We have also entered stage 3 where most businesses are cautiously re-opened, but with social-distancing. We are grateful for volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time to assist us so that we can ensure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please check your body temperature before leaving home. Wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourselves and others and have available sanitizers.
- 4) For the months of July and August at least, we shall not have servers, nor choir/music during Mass. Should the situation improve, we shall carefully open up gradually to ensure there is no second wave of infection. We keep the regular schedule in order to ensure not too many will be turned away when Mass resumed. We shall help you fill your container with holy water, and vigil lights can be lit only before Masses. Offerings for vigil lights can be placed in the tube near the statue of Mary. Please do not linger in church after Mass, as we need time to sanitize the church. Entrance will be at the main door and exit will be near the ramp door by St. Joseph's statue.
- 5) We continue to live-stream Mass at the 4:30pm Saturday and 10:00 am Mass on Sundays whenever possible. Those who have a computer, cell phone or other electronic devices can benefit from it. Please connect via the parish website at www.fatimaparish.ca
- 6) During the months of July and August the bulletins will be available every two weeks. If necessary, we shall send you an email message to update you on evolving situations.
- 7) Parents of young people who were confirmed in February can pick up the certificate by sending me an e-mail at pastor@fatimaparish.ca or calling me at 613-722-7661x3. You can meet me at the shrine or outside the rectory door at a specified time. Looking forward to meeting with you!
- 8) We are thankful that weekend worship is possible, but things are not yet back to normal. At this time we shall keep the regular confession and Mass schedule (Monday-Friday morning Masses only). Anything beyond will have to wait until we have some normalcy.
