1) Our parish welcomes all who are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian church and seek full communion with the



Catholic Church. Please inform me and we shall begin the process without delay! Initiating new Catholic Christians is the responsibility of all the baptized. "The initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful" [#4]. Every sacrament—eucharist, reconciliation, marriage, anointing of the sick and so on—takes place within the community of faith!

- 2) One of the important roles as Pastor in a contemporary church is that of faith-community building, which echoes Pope Francis' ongoing summons to walk with the faithful and encourage them to missionary discipleship, in other words, to follow Christ and give of ourselves in the way he directs us to live life to its fullness. Joyfully reaching out to others who worship with us, making sure if they are new, that we exercise hospitality and welcome them, and invite them to serve and minister to the community are essential components of living our discipleship.
- 3) I once heard from pastoral council members when I was assigned to a parish of what they consider are keys for a pastor in his ministry. The answer is this: "deep faith; strength in liturgy to make the gospel's message relevant to everyday life; the ability to listen, without being judgmental; an openness to and acceptance of the uniqueness of every person and respect for all; the ability to encourage dialogue; a recognition and acceptance of the tremendous diversity of individuals in our community; the ability to harness the gifts of all in our community and to reach out to those who want to join us; inclusiveness; and the ability to be part of many teams." As I reflected on Christ as our shepherd at last weekend's homily, I would like to encourage you for your collaboration as we seek to help one another in deepening our relationship with Christ in discipleship.
- 4) We have several volunteers who helped bring communion to the residents of Carlingwood Retirement Home across the park from us. Thursday appears not to be a good time for religious service as the residents have other activities. We hope to resume religious service on Saturday morning. Parishioners who can assist please contact me or the office.
