1) Our parish welcomes all who are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian church and seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Please inform me and we shall begin the process without delay! Initiating new Catholic Christians is the responsibility of all the baptized. “The initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful” [#4]. Every sacrament—eucharist, reconciliation, marriage, anointing of the sick and so on—takes place within the community!

2) Singing is very important at Mass, please do not delegate to the choir to sing for us. Presiding priest and congregation use our voices to give praise and thanks to God. “Thus St. Augustine says rightly, “Singing is for one who loves,” and there is also an ancient proverb: “Whoever sings well prays twice over.” [General instructions, #39] Great importance should be attached to singing in the celebration of Mass, especially at weekend Masses. Every care should be taken that singing be part of the celebration. [#40].

3) Some parishioners rely on para-transpo and need to leave early when the Mass is a little longer, that I can understand. However, at Sunday worship we give full, active and conscious participation as members of one another in Christ. Courtesy to other parishioners is important if we are truly the Body of Christ. Unless something urgently awaits us, the habit of leaving right after having received communion gives the impression that we have little regard for the fact that Christ gathers us as a Community in Communion with one another. If you can, please get into the habit of waiting after the final blessing and the dismissal!

4) Please pray for the funerals that have been celebrated in July for: Patricia Babcock [July 4], Alfred Dupont [July 5], Patrick Shean [July 14], he was actively involved in the funeral serving team. Also pray for the upcoming funeral for Urban Charlebois [July 25]. Parishioners are always invited to attend funeral Masses to give support and consolation to the grieving families in our parish community.
