1) Trinity Sunday Reflection:

Trinity Sunday is the first Sunday after the Easter Season. The

gospel gives us the great text of John 3:16-18 about God as love. The Trinity is expressed about God's nature and being as love in communion, but also as God's project and outreach. The world is the arena of divine love, the outflow of divine love is the Spirit that touches humans to make appropriate response. In the Sunday eucharist, the divine tenderness is manifested in the Spirit of the Risen Lord: one who is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness. May we place our trust in God who loves the world, even though it can be rather messy sometimes.

2) According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the Church recommends "that more perfect form of participation in the Mass by which the faithful, after the Priest's Communion, receive the Lord's Body from the same Sacrifice." [#13] We only use the reserved hosts from the tabernacle whenever we run short.

Also, communion under both kinds enables the faithful to participate in a "clearer form of the sacramental sign" [#14]. In our parish, at the 10am Masses on Sundays, we already have the custom of receiving both the host and the cup. We aim at extending the practice to all Sunday Masses by the First Sunday of Advent. In the meantime, it is appropriate to receive both species also on the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ [the weekend Masses of June 17-18].

- 3) A slight change will take place beginning the Canada Day Weekend. The Roman Missal requires that we make the brief announcements after the Prayer after Communion, rather than before, as is our current custom. Hopefully the announcements will be rather brief, and we can remain standing until the final blessings.


