### Refugee Assistance

### **UPDATE ON OLF REFUGEE MINISTRY:**

Thanks to the generous contributions of our parishioners in our 2015/16 fund raising drive, OLF undertook to sponsor a Syrian refugee family forced to flee their war torn homeland. We are happy to advise you that that family is doing well and the parents and children are making Ottawa their home. We have now

submitted a sponsorship application for another Syrian refugee family related to our resettled family. We hope to welcome this family, with 4 children from ages 7 to 19 soon though there have been complications with their application. We anticipate that, for the most part, the financial needs of this family will be fulfilled by remaining resources from the original fundraising drive. However, from our previous experience, we know that the family will benefit from personal associations with parishioners who can help them with specific tasks. We will be reaching out for volunteers to support specific aspects of the resettlement in the future. The balance of the monies from the original fundraising drive have been used to support another Diocesan project. Holy Redeemer Parish was approached by a woman looking for a sponsor to bring four siblings and a young orphaned niece to Canada. Her family was forced to flee the Congo as refugees. Having arrived in Canada herself as a refugee many years before, she knew first hand the difficulties her relatives would be facing as they left their home country in search of safety. Holy Redeemer has agreed to be the sponsorship holder and we are pleased to have offered financial assistance in support of their undertaking. We at OLF are blessed to be able to assist these families to make a new life in Ottawa. We shall continue to keep parishioners informed as the OLF community works to fulfill our refugee mission.

HANDICRAFT HOLY LAND CHRISTIANS – The weekend of June 8-9 we will have with us a special guest Sebastien Cardinal representing "Handicraft Holy Land Christians", who after the masses will briefly address the issues and concerns regarding the Christian presence in the Holy Land. 
