1) As a result of retirement or health issues, we need to ask some retirees to help with serving at funerals. If you



are available to help, please call Peter Cromwell (613-829-4295). A reminder that the parish needs your generous exercise of discipleship in order to make it vibrant as a community of faith!

- 2) The Rites of Adult initiation 'demand a revolutionary shift from our recent history of inquiry classes and catechisms... or of private instructions leading to entry into passive, unaware congregations... (but) conversion to Christ, through the Spirit in a welcoming, committed faith-filled community that "renews their own conversion" and "provides an example that will help the catechumens to obey the Holy Spirit more generously" (RCIA, 4). (Echoing God's Word, by James Dunning, 1993, p.5). Initiation is about changing a vision of church as a community not just to receive sacraments but to be a sacrament and to do the sacraments: "The initiation of catechumens is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful" (4), and "The people of God... should understand and show by their concern that the initiation of adults is the responsibility of all the baptized" (9)... every sacrament - eucharist, reconciliation, marriage, anointing of the sick and so on - takes place within the community and is the responsibility of all the baptized! That change might give life to all the sacraments. It calls the entire community beyond mere vocal and sung responses at liturgy to the genuine "full, conscious and active participation" envisioned by Vatican II." (Echoing God's Word, p.8)
- 3) Singing is very important at Mass, please do not delegate to the choir to sing for us. Presiding priest and congregation use our voices to give praise and thanks to God. "Thus St. Augustine says rightly, "Singing is for one who loves," and there is also an ancient proverb: "Whoever sings well prays twice over." (General instructions, #39). Great importance should be attached to singing in the celebration of Mass, especially at weekend Masses. Every care should be taken that singing be part of the celebration. (#40).
- 4) Some parishioners rely on para-transpo and need to leave early when the Mass is a little longer, that I can understand. However, at Sunday worship we give full, active and conscious participation as members of one another in Christ. Courtesy to other parishioners is important if we are truly the Body of Christ. Unless something urgently awaits us, the habit of leaving right after having received communion gives the impression that we have little regard for the fact that Christ gathers us as a Community in Communion with one another. If you can, please get into the habit of waiting after the final blessing and the dismissal! God, the author of time and everything that we are and have, would be more pleased if we give a little of our time to render God praise and thanksgiving!
- 5) We give thanks to the Ladies of Fatima for hosting the Strawberry dinner last Thursday and coffee Sunday as well as to the Knights of Columbus for the Steak and Chicken dinner last weekend.
